Zach has shown perseverance in many ways this week. He has been practising cutting with scissors and persevered to complete the activity.


He has also shown a keen interest in our winter topic, using his senses to explore snow, ice & frost alongside his friends!

Hunter loves finding out about the past and important people that have helped shaped our world.








### Wrens – Paisley

Great job River.






Sam – Falcons

She behaves in a mature and sensible manner, setting a really good example to others.




### Sparrows - Oliver

Well done Darcey, we are very proud of you.




### Wrens Class




### Henry- Hawks
