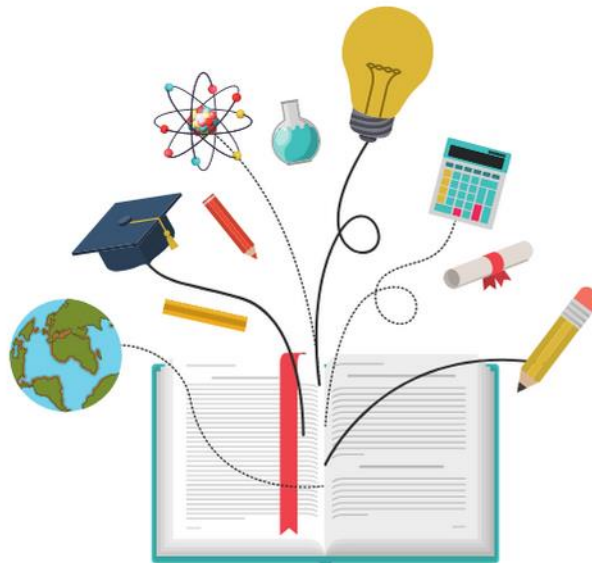

Sparrows - Louie

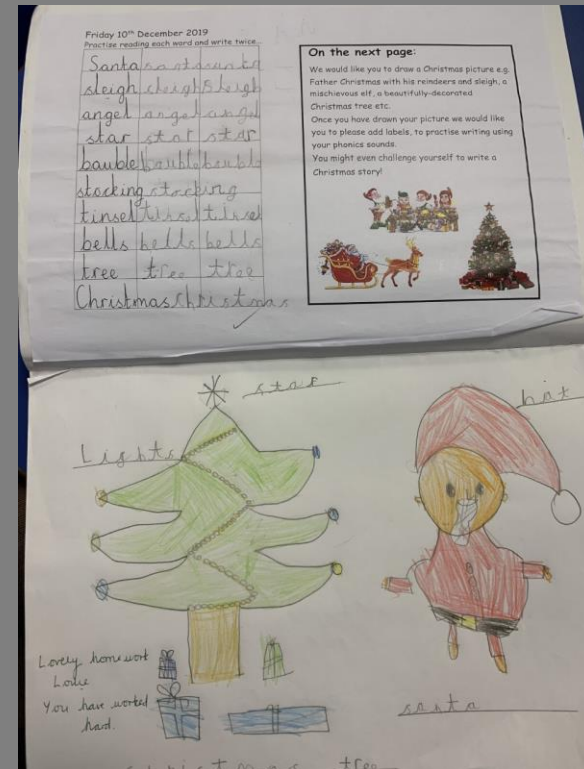
Every week Louie has produced a fantastic piece of homework. His handwriting has really improved and the Christmas pictures he drew this week were stunning.

Wrens – Brooke

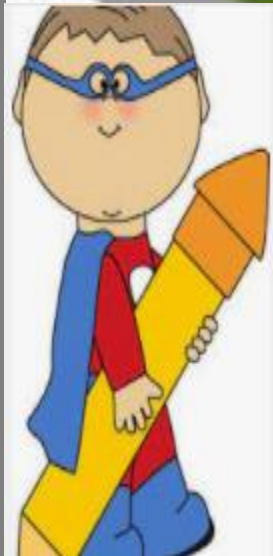

Year 4



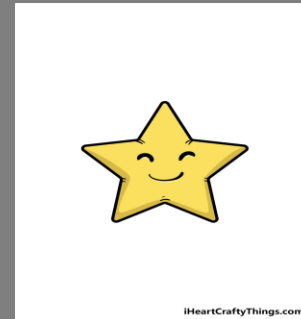
Liam – Buzzards

WOODPECKERS – Freddie

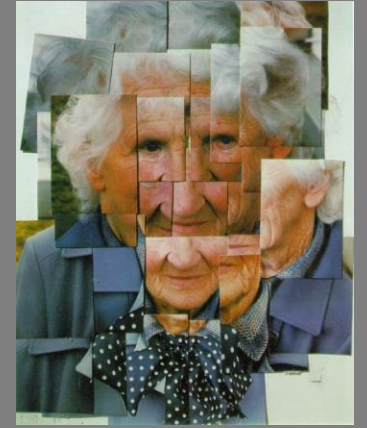

She always tries her best and shows true integrity.

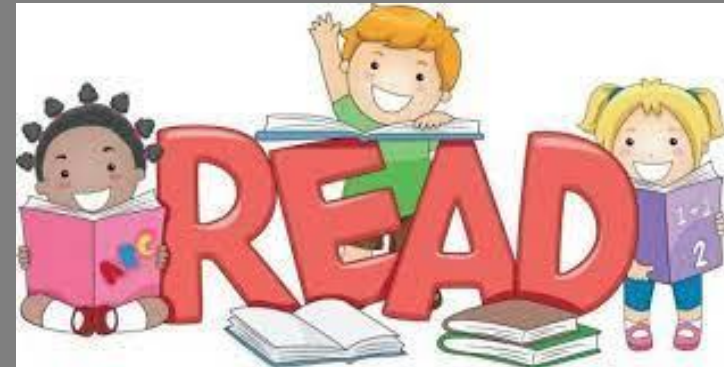

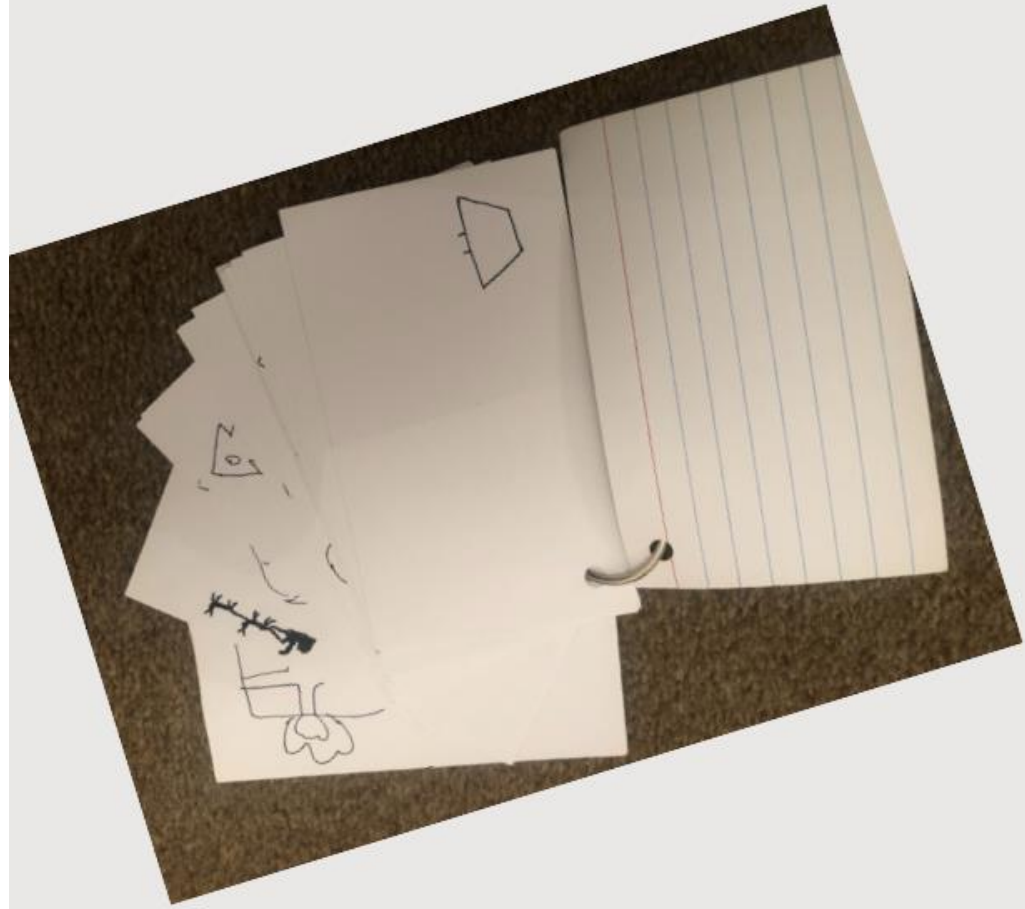
