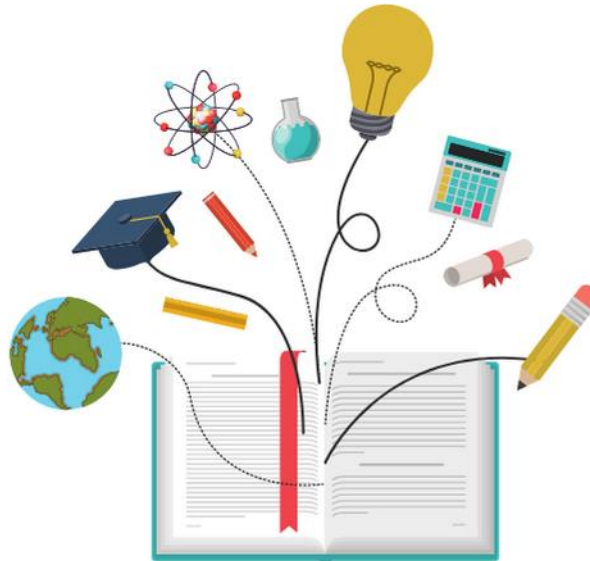

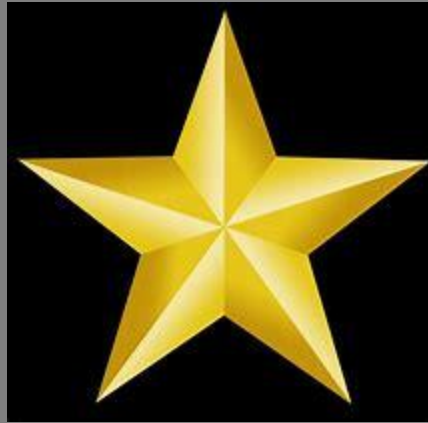
Year 2

This week in Geography we have been learning about places. We have looked at where we live and have compared it to a different location in the world.

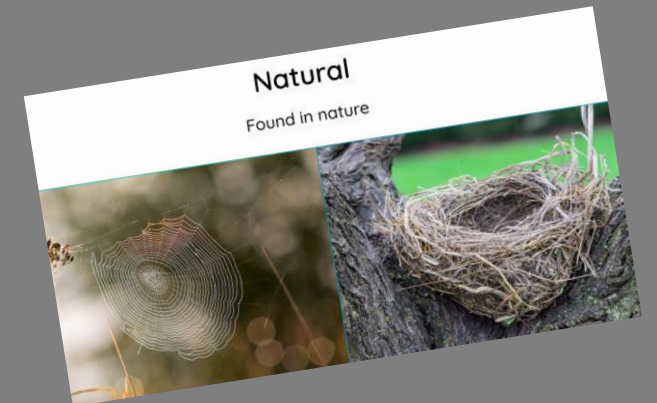

Wrens - Ollie

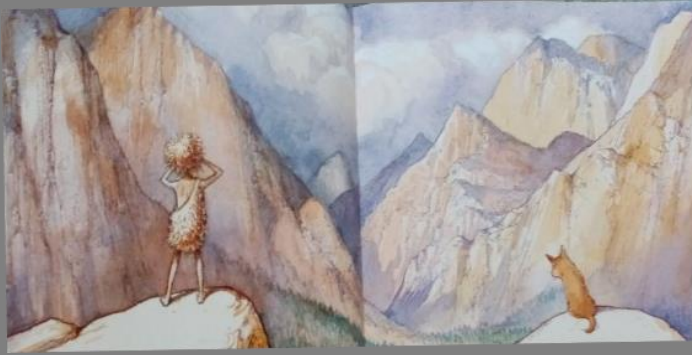

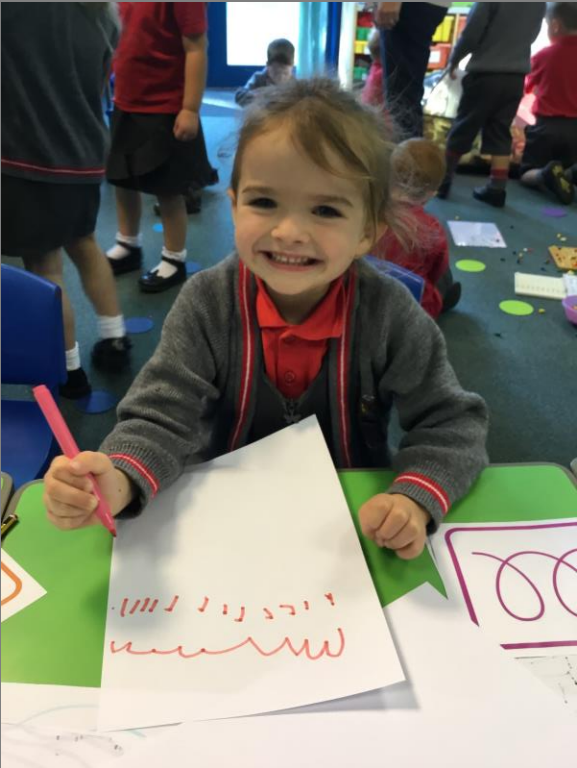

Libby

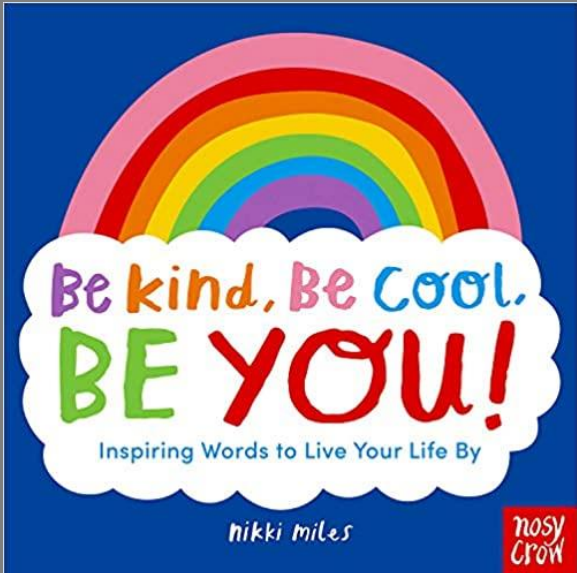

What an amazing role model you are – always thinking of other people. Well done Amelia.

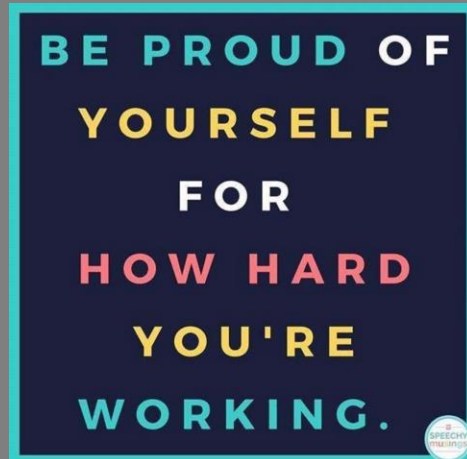
Year 2
