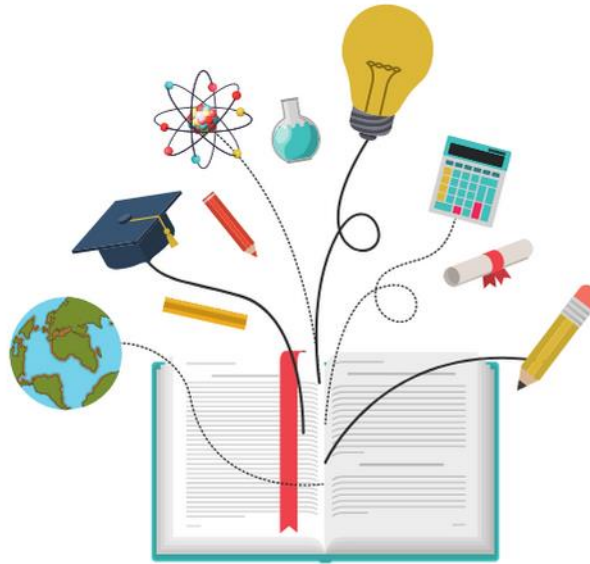

Hudson L

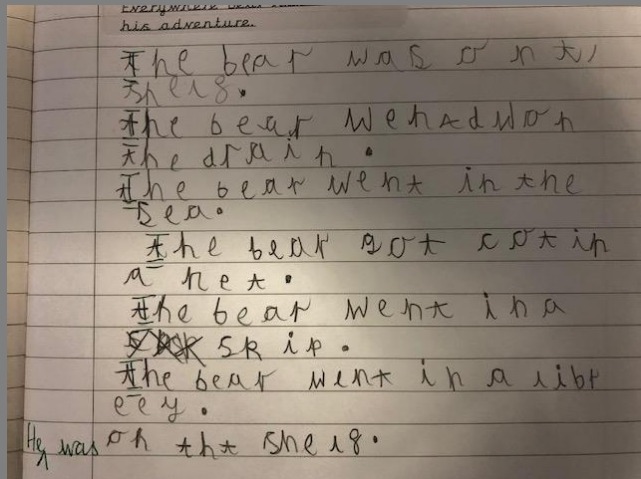

Year 1

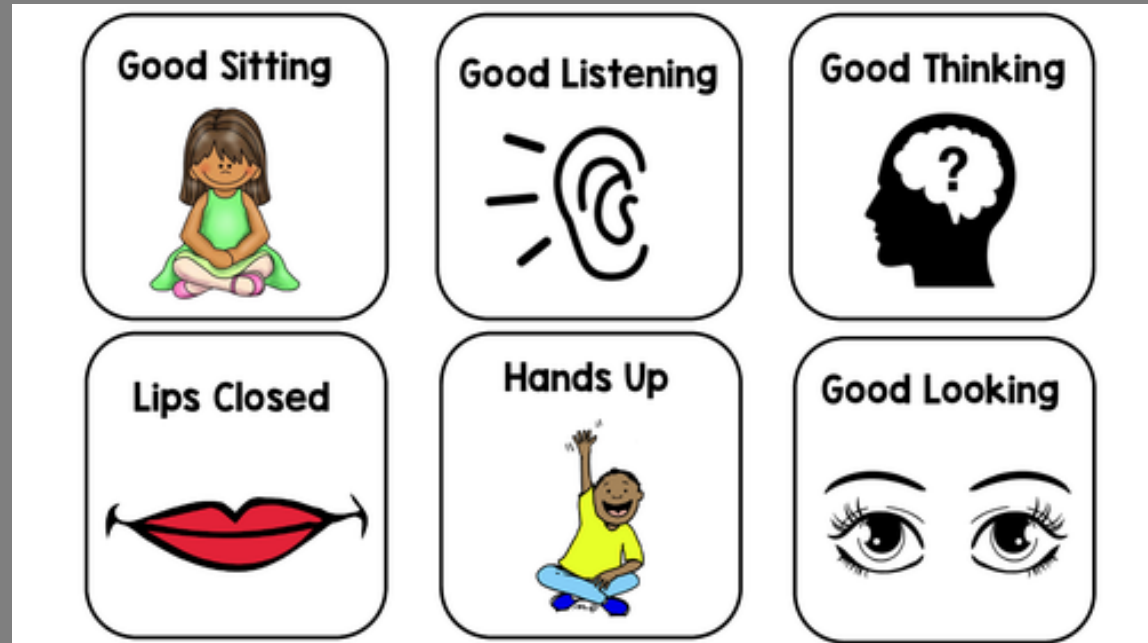
Owls – Maisey

Sparrows – Theo

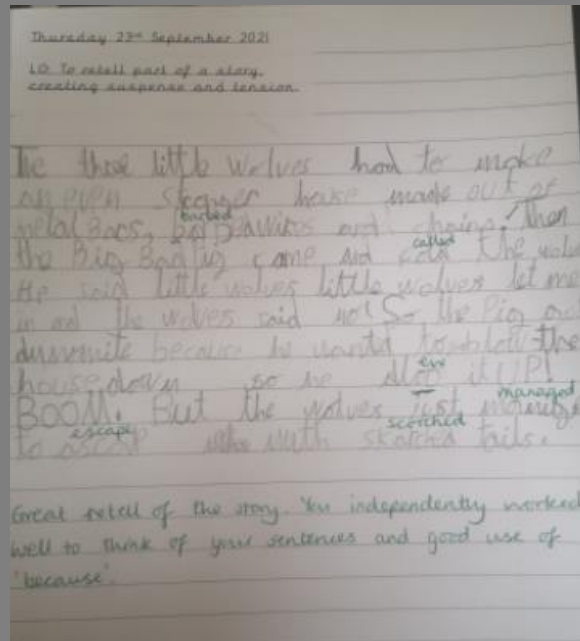

Wrens – Kaya

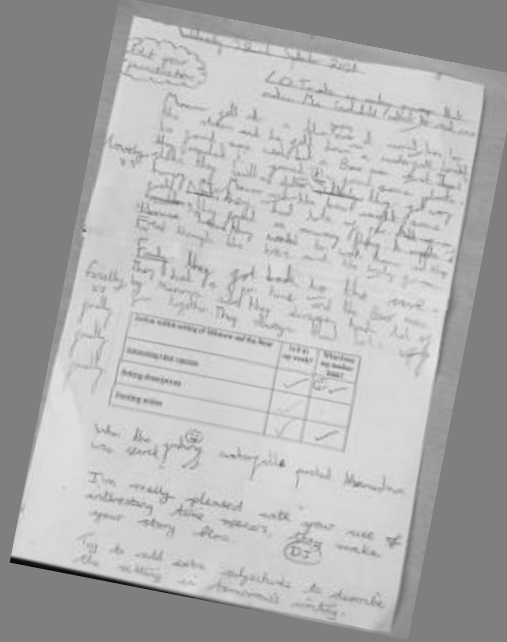
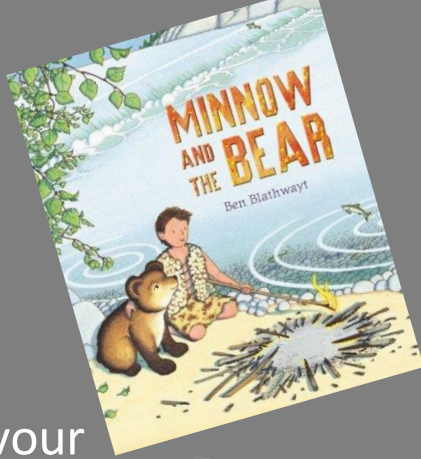

Year 3

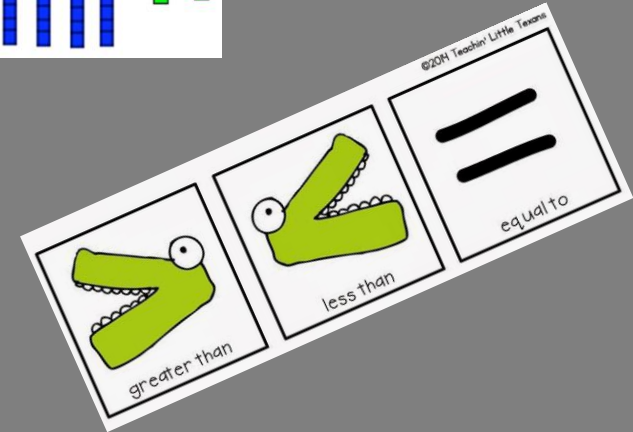
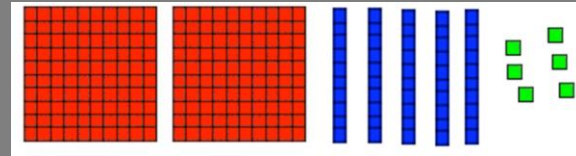
Isla H Jackdaws

Giselle— Cranes

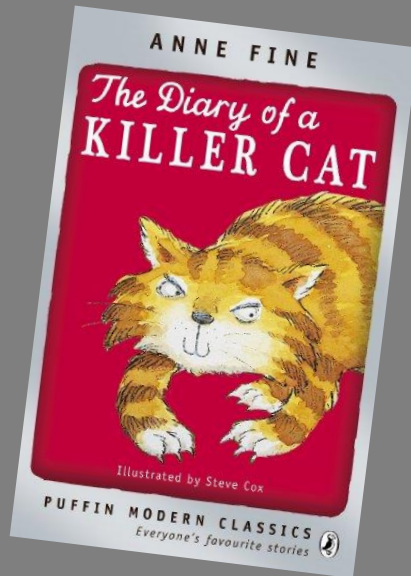

Pippa – Buzzards

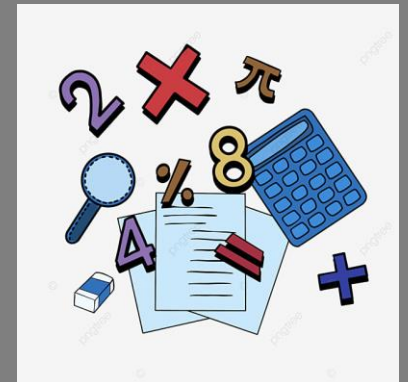

Keep up the fantastic work!



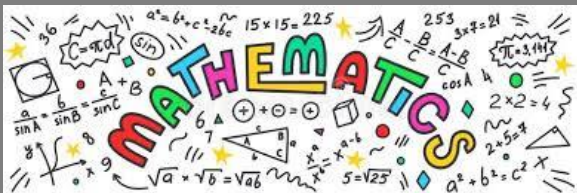
Year 5

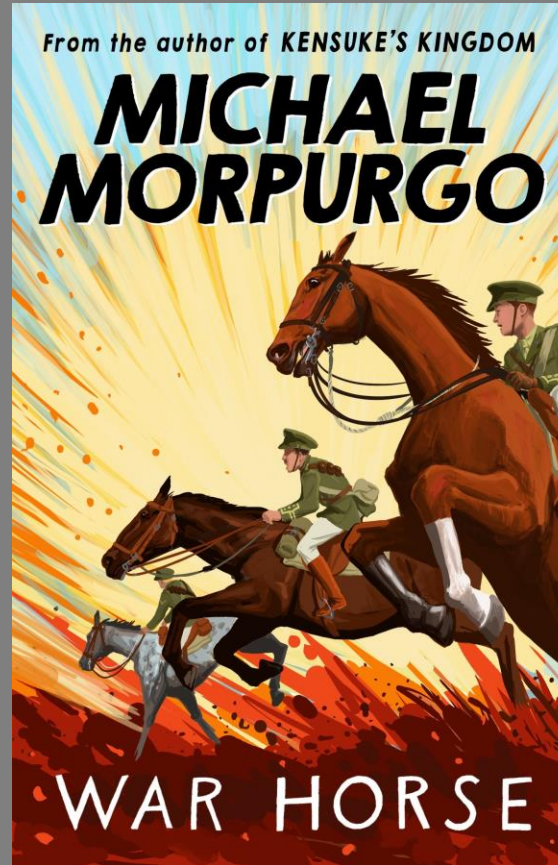
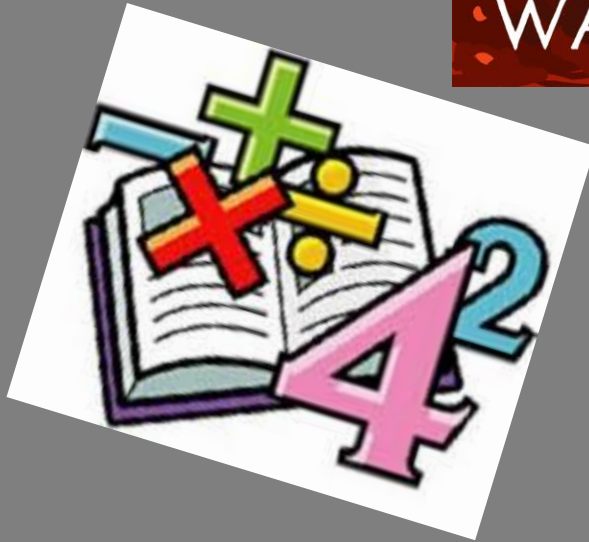

Year 1

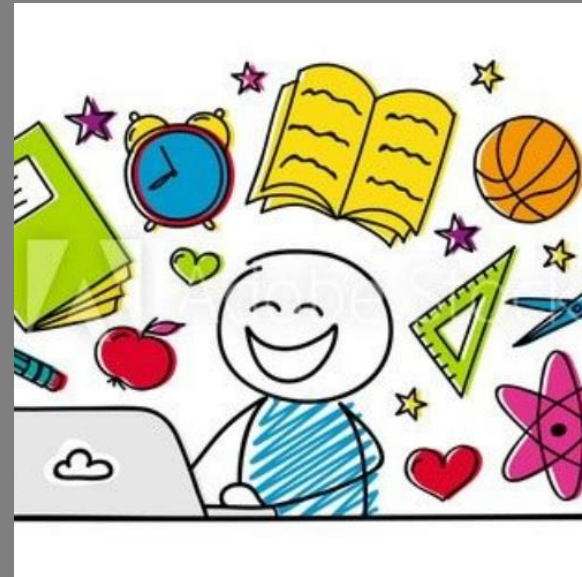
Owls - Miles

Wrens – Lucy

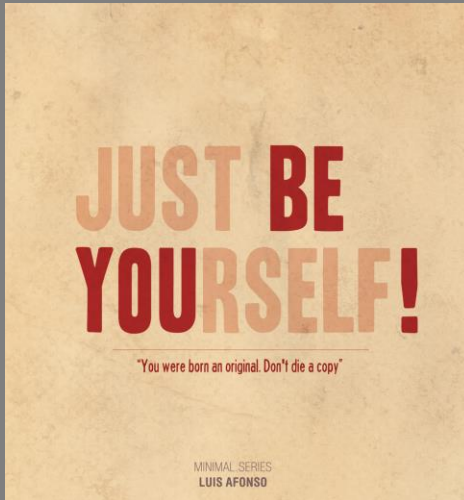

Keep up the hard work!!

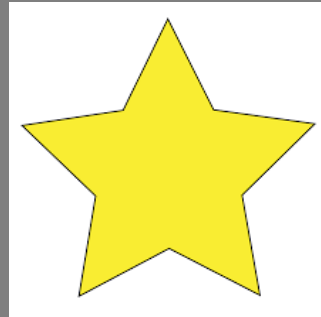


Year 5

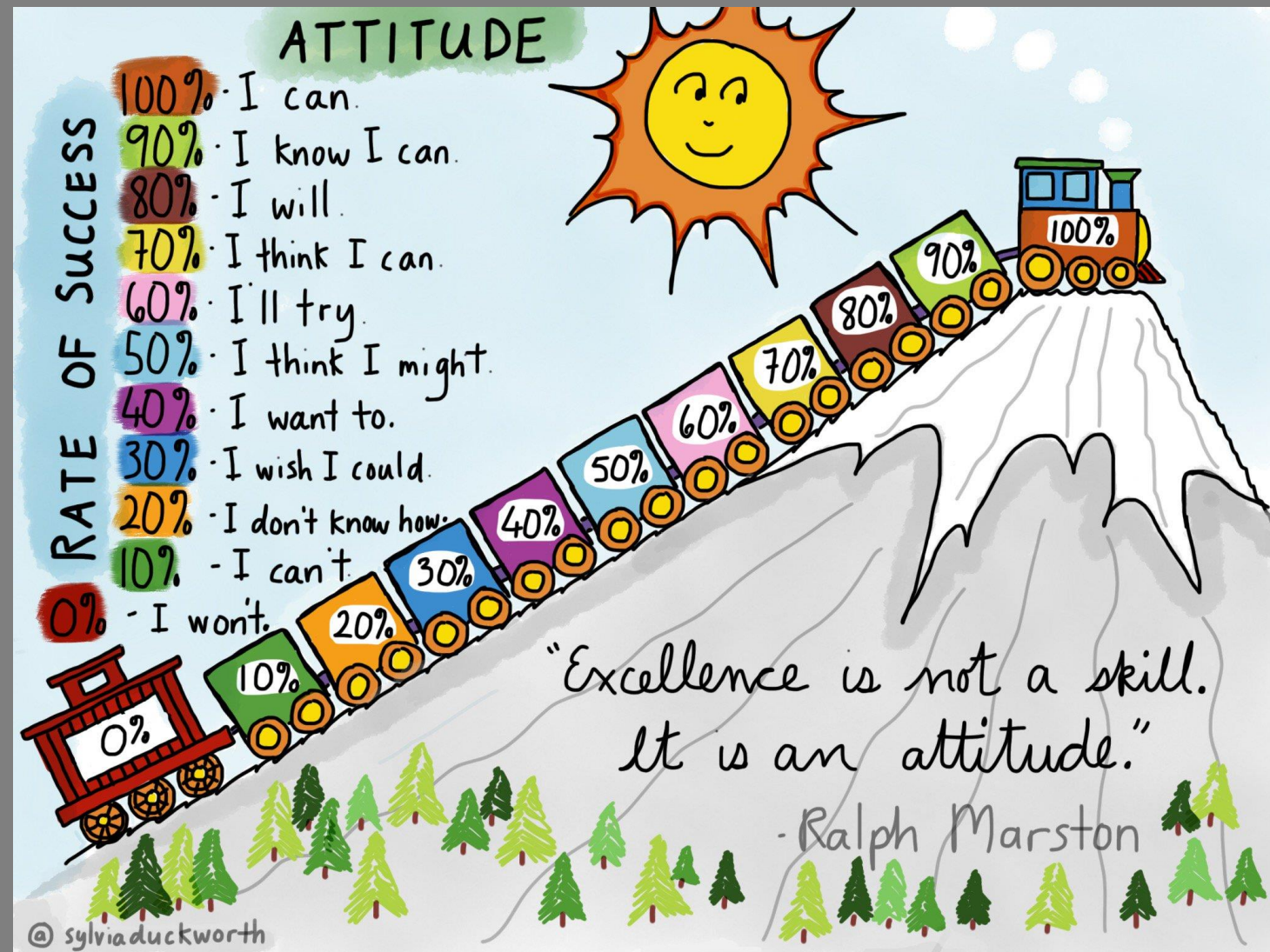
