
Robins - Harley Fenton

You remembered that Muslims go to a Mosque for worship. You spoke in a clear and precise voice.


Great remembering of knowledge that you have learnt in the past.

Wrens – Brax






Brooke Jackdaws



Annie – Cranes




Well done Henry, I'm so proud of you!

Finches – Abbey


This week Abbey you have shown the school value of compassion.




Bethan- Hawks
