Libby doesn't always find things easy but has worked so hard with her reading and writing this term.


She has made great progress – keep it up Libby!

Keep up this fantastic writing and super attitude!






Finches-Jacob

Great knowledge shared this week.







Wrens – Edina






Marley – Buzzards

We hope this positive attitude continues! Well done Poppy!







Evie-Jackdaws






Phoebe- Hawks
