


EYFS

work!








Sparrows - Reegan

Finches - Myles


Our topic of The Great Fire of London in both our English work and History work has enthused all the children in Finches class.

Wrens – Reuben


Reuben has thoroughly enjoyed the History work about the Great Fire of London. He has written some fantastic sentences describing the action.




<u>Bea – Cranes</u>




Luke- Hawks

In addition, you were able to use the term air resistance correctly to explain what happened in the investigation you carried out.






Woodpeckers – Evie-Leigh










Charlie – Cranes

Keep on showing compassion it will make our school and our world a better place!








Oliver B- Hawks


