<p>Resources</p> <p>Tablets or cameras</p>	<p>Preparation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prepare the adult that will work with groups doing the technology search in session 1. Make sure they are aware of the different types of technology around the school. • As adults we think about technology from the use of flint to cut up food in Stoneage times, to paper for books, to electronic devices today. This activity is about today's technology. The devices around our school and homes that can help us in different ways. • Download 'Technology in my Home' presentation – or use photos children have brought from home. • Have number cards 1 – 16 by printing out slides 4 – 19 or use numbered photos children have brought from home.

1	<p>Technology in our Lives</p> <p>I can recognise ways that technology is used in my home and community.</p> <p>I can begin to identify some of the benefits of using technology.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ask the children what technology they can see in the classroom. • Rehearse the names of the items, emphasising initial sounds/letters. • Tell the children they are going to have the opportunity to work in groups to go on a technology hunt around the school. They will collect photos of technology in school. They must find technology beginning with eg: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ p (printer, projector) ○ c (copier, CD player) ○ h (hub for wireless or internet coming into the school) ○ w (whiteboard) ○ t (tablet) ○ l (laptop) ○ th (thermostat) • Prompt the adult working with each group to encourage talk about the purpose for using each technology they spot. • Use photos for sorting and Handling Data activities. (See Handling Data 2) • Plenary: Play I-Spy technology in the classroom or in another area of the school. • Ask the children to do a technology search at home and bring in a list of the technology they find.
