Pit Stop - Change of Building Tuesday 10th June

Reminders for Drop-off / Collection times

In order to make sure children stay safe we need to give a few reminders to families:

- Keep children close to you at drop off and collection times
- Children should not play on the EYFS outdoor area / in the garden
- Ensure children walk out of gates and down the big path next to the field. Sometimes, children charge off and fall or can't always stop themselves in time before meeting the road.

Trainer Season - Please Avoid.

As we move through the final half term, we often see a rise in children wearing trainers to school, usually with the understandable reason that school shoes are now too small and new ones are on hold until September. If this is the case for your child, please do send them in with a pair of pumps to change into for the school day. When a few children begin wearing trainers, it tends to snowball VERY rapidly —and before long, other parts of our uniform policy start to slip too. We're really proud of our school and want every child to feel equal, without the pressure of keeping up with trends or feeling left-out based on what they wear. Thank you for helping us keep things fair, consistent, and focused on what really matters.
