Braiswick will be replacing Tempest Photography, who have previously provided this service. We are confident that Braiswick will deliver high-quality photographs at a more competitive price and a smooth experience for both pupils and families.

Once all the photographs have been taken, school will receive the proof cards to give to parents and carers. This usually takes about a week. The proof cards will have all the information required to place the order and what products are available to purchase. Parents and carers can then place the order online directly with the company.
