A Big Thank You from Wrap Up Central Lancashire

Thank you for the collection for the Rotary Wrap Up Central Lancashire project, which ran from 29th of September till 24th of October. Once again, the programme was a huge success, and in the Central Lancashire area alone we collected a total of 1445 immediately usable coats across 28 collection points. There were also a further 220 items of coats and clothing that were not suitable for the programme but will not be wasted and have been delivered to the International Aid Trust for distribution into the charitable projects they support and 74 hats, scarves, gloves which were taken by one of the charities

We distributed to 11 very worth local charities, several of which receive referrals from a large number of agencies such as Social Services, foodbanks, refuges etc and I am pleased to say all these coats have now been distributed and have been well received, as there continues to be a real need for these coats in the present circumstances.
