We would like to inform you that our school will be used as a polling station on Thursday 7th May for the local elections. **The school will remain open and the school day will run as normal for all pupils.**

The polling station will be located in The Nest (Junior Site). Voter access will be via the path from Livesey Branch Road, along the recreation ground path, and through the playground gate on the rec. path. Please note that the back of the school, from the gate near the recreation ground, will be cordoned off. As a result, there will be no access to the playground for children and parents via the Feniscowles Recreation Ground gate. All children must enter school via the main playground gates.

We have systems in place to ensure the smooth running of the day, and the safety and security of all children will be maintained at all times. Thank you for your cooperation.

Parking Reminder

Please be reminded that the staff car park is for staff use only and has very limited spaces. Unfortunately, we have had several occasions where staff have been blocked in by parents parking in this area.
